#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the number, also the number of pounds, of land-locked salmon, trout, togue and white perch which can be taken or had in possession in any one day by one person.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,

- 2 catch, kill or have in possession in any one day more than
- 3 fifteen pounds of land-locked salmon, trout, togue or white
- 4 perch (unless an individual fish so taken exceeds fifteen
- 5 pounds in weight) or more than forty fish in all.

Sect. 2. No person shall transport more than fifteen

- 2 pounds or one fish if weighing more than fifteen pounds,
- 3 of land-locked salmon, trout, togue or white perch in all

- 4 at any one time, nor shall any corporation transport more 5 than fifteen pounds in all, of trout, togue, land-locked sal-6 mon or white perch at one time as the property of any one 7 person; nor shall any such be transported except in the 8 possession of the owner thereof, plainly labeled thereon with 9 the owner's name and residence, except as is provided in 10 Section 28 of Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as 11 amended.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 Section shall be punished by a fine of fifty dollars for each 3 offense and one dollar for every pound of fish so taken or 4 being transported in excess of fifteen pounds, and all such 5 fish being so transported or taken in violation of this Sec-6 tion may be seized and shall be forfeited to the state. Who-7 ever has in his possession more than fifteen pounds in all, 8 of said fish, shall be deemed to have taken them in violagion of this act; provided, however, that the taking of 10 one fish additional having less than fifteen pounds shall not 11 be regarded as a violation of the law.
  - Sect. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
