STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, for the introduction of the Hungarian Partridge in the State of Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars 2 may be taken from the appropriation for the operation of 3 the fish hatcheries and feeding stations and for the protection of fish, game and birds, to be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and game for the purpose of imforming Hungarian partridges, to be liberated in such places 7 in the State of Maine as said commissioners may deem suit-8 able.
