STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-five of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes relating to Free High Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section fifty-five of chapter fifteen of the re-2 vised statutes is hereby repealed and the following substi-3 tuted therefor:

'Sect. 55. No town shall receive state aid for the main-5 tenance of a free high school unless its appropriation and 6 expenditure for such school has been exclusive of the 7 amounts required by law for common school purposes.'
