IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and nine in regard to the use of automobiles on the Island of Mount Desert.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-  
2 three of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thou-  
3 sand nine hundred and nine, entitled "An Act to prohibit  
4 the use of automobiles in the towns of Eden, Mount Desert,  
5 Tremont and Southwest Harbor, on the Island of Mount  
6 Desert," is hereby amended by striking out the words "any  
7 of" in the third line of said section and adding the word  
8 'any' between the words "Eden" and "Mount Desert" in the

9 third line of said section, and striking out the words “Tremont” and “Southwest Harbor” in the fourth line of said  
10 section, so that said section when amended shall read as  
11 follows:  
12 follows:

‘Section 1. No automobile or motor vehicle shall be set up,  
14 used, driven or operated in or or any highway, town way, or  
15 public street, within the towns of Eden and Mount Desert,  
16 on the island of Mount Desert, in the County of Hancock,  
17 State of Maine.’

Sect. 2. The provisions of this act or any previous act shall  
2 not apply to a certain public highway leading directly from  
3 said town of Tremont to the town of Trenton, which is de-  
4 fined as follows: Beginning on the highway or road at the  
5 center, at the town line between the said towns of Tremont  
6 and Mount Desert, thence following the main travelled high-  
7 way or road in a northerly direction in said Mount Desert  
8 to Pretty Marsh Corner, thence in a general northwesterly  
9 direction following the main travelled highway or road in  
10 said Mount Desert to Smith’s Corner, so called, thence  
11 northerly following the main travelled highway or road in  
12 said Mount Desert to the Eden town line near High Head,  
13 thence northerly over the main travelled highway or road  
14 in Eden through Indian Point, so called, to Bunker’s Cor-  
15 ner at Town Hill, thence northerly following the main trav-  
16 elled highway or road in Eden through the Cousens Dis-  
17 trict, so called, to the town of Trenton; said highway or  
18 road to be used for ingress and egress to and from the town  
19 of Tremont on said Island of Mount Desert to said town  
20 of Trenton.’
