STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT requiring street railroads to file profiles with their locations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. In all proceedings before the railroad com-

- 2 missioners by street railroad corporations, involving the
- 3 approval of locations outside of the limits of streets, roads
- 4 or ways, such corporations shall file profiles of the proposed
- 5 location outside of the limits of streets, roads or ways and
- 6 such profiles of the streets, roads or ways as may be ma-
- 7 terial to the inquiry into the approval of the proposed loca-
- 8 tion. Such profiles shall be on the relative scales of profile
- 9 paper in common use.
