STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to insurance on public buildings and other State property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All fire and liability insurance upon public

- 2 buildings and other property belonging to the State of
- 3 Maine shall be placed thereon by the several boards of
- 4 trustees having said property in charge, subject to the ap-
- 5 proval of the Governor and Council, or by the Governor
- 6 and Council, and all expense therefor shall be paid from the
- 7 several appropriations for insurance on said property.

Sect. 2. All policies issued by virtue of the authority of

Sect. 3. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this

2 Act are hereby repealed.
