STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of pensions granted by special resolves of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. That all pensions granted by special resolve of
the Legislature to dependent soldiers and sailors or dependnt relatives thereof shall be paid by the state pension clerk,
from the regular appropriations made for state pensions.
