STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Stenographers to the Recording
Officers of the Senate and House.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to Margaret F.
3 Sheehan of Bucksport, for services as stenographer and
4 typewriter to the secretary of the Senate; and four hundred
5 and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated to be paid to Sarah
6 P. Winslow of Dexter, for services as stenographer and
7 typewriter to the clerk of the House; said services being
8 rendered in the preparation of the journals of the Senate
9 and House, and to be rendered in the preparation of the
10 indexes of said journals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is drawn in accordance with orders, one introduced in the Senate on January 4, 1911, by Senator Chandler of Washington, and one in the House on the same date, by Mr. Bogue of East Machias, authorizing the secretary of the Senate and the clerk of the House to procure the services of a stenographer and typewriter during the present session.
