STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 194 of the Public Laws of 1909 in relation to doors swinging outward; fire escapes or egresses from factories, workshops, tenement houses, halls and tenements; inspection, etc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes as amended 2 by chapter 194 of the Public Laws of 1909 in relation to 3 doors swinging outward; fire escapes or egresses from fac- 4 tories, workshops, tenement houses, halls and tenements; 5 inspection, etc., is hereby amended by adding the following 6 section:

'Sect. 46. Should it come to the notice of the State fac- 8 tory inspector or his deputy, or should complaint be made

9 to such State factory inspector or his deputy by any citizen
10 of the State, of the failure of any of the above named offi-
11 cers to comply with any of the provisions of this act, the
12 State factory inspector or his deputy shall at once proceed
13 to investigate such complaint, and if sufficient evidence can
14 be obtained, he shall at once file a complaint against such
15 officer with the county attorney, who shall prosecute the same
16 under the provisions of this act.'
