IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to abolish the office of recorder of the Western  
Hancock Municipal Court.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section three of chapter 613 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 314 of the  
3 Private and Special Laws of 1895, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. Said chapter 613 of Private and Special Laws  
2 of 1893 is further amended by striking out in the eleventh  
3 line of section two, the thirty-first line of section eight, the  
4 second line of section ten, and in the fifteenth line of sec-  
5 tion sixteen, the words "or recorder."

Sect. 3. Section twenty-one of said chapter 613 is hereby  
2 repealed.

Sect. 4. Trial justices residing within the county of Han-  
2 cock shall have and exercise the same jurisdiction as though  
3 the Western Hancock Municipal Court had never been es-  
4 tablished.
