## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to abolish the office of recorder of the Western Hancock Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Section three of chapter 613 of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 314 of the
- 3 Private and Special Laws of 1895, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. Said chapter 613 of Private and Special Laws

- 2 of 1893 is further amended by striking out in the eleventh
- 3 line of section two, the thirty-first line of section eight, the
- 4 second line of section ten, and in the fifteenth line of sec-
- 5 tion sixteen, the words "or recorder."

- Sect. 3. Section twenty-one of said chapter 613 is hereby 2 repealed.
- Sect. 4. Trial justices residing within the county of Han-2 cock shall have and exercise the same jurisdiction as though 3 the Western Hancock Municipal Court had never been es-4 tablished.
