STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to permit the plantation of Number Fourteen to
assume the maintenance of its roads and bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The plantation of Number Fourteen in Wash-
2 ington county shall have the right, by accepting the pro-
3 visions of this act, to assume the maintenance and repair of
4 the ways and bridges within its borders by raising and ex-
5 pending money therefor, in which case it shall be subject to
6 the provisions of section one hundred and eighteen of chap-
7 ter four of the revised statutes and also those of section
8 forty-one of chapter twenty-three of said revised statutes,
9 as amended.

Sect. 2. Said plantation may accept the provisions hereof

2 on or before the first day of November, in the year of our
3 Lord nineteen hundred and twelve, in which case the clerk
4 of said plantation shall immediately notify the clerk of the
5 county commissioners of Washington county of such action,
6 who shall make a record of that fact, and thereupon said
7 commissioners shall be relieved from all duties respecting
8 the ways and bridges in that plantation from and after the
9 first day of December following said action of said planta-
10 tion.
