RESOLVE in favor of the Clerk, Stenographer and the Mes-
senger to the Judiciary Committee.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to Elisha
2 W. Pike the sum of five hundred dollars for services as
3 clerk to the Judiciary Committee, and that the sum of forty-
4 eight dollars and seventy-three cents (\$48.73) be paid to
5 said clerk to reimburse him for the rental of typewriters,
6 for postage stamps used by him in forwarding legislative
7 notices, and telegraph and telephone expenses; and that
8 there be appropriated and paid to Frances A. Baker the
9 sum of one hundred and fifty dollars for services as stenog-
10 rapher to said committee; and that there be appropriated
11 and paid to Foster Mansell the sum of one hundred and
12 fifty dollars for services as messenger to said committee.
