### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The committee held two sessions, afternoon and evening, to hear statements and arguments on the bill, and employed a stenographer to report all the proceedings, said sessions occupying from 2.30 o'clock to 6 and from 7.30 to 12, the stenographer recording 75,000 words in that time, equivalent in volume to three days' work, and he has charged for his services \$25.
