## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to grant additional rights to married women.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever, being a female person more than

- 2 eighteen years of age, debauches and carnally knows, car-
- 3 ries on criminal conversation with, alienates the affections
- 4 of, the husband of any married woman, or by any arts, en-
- 5 ticements, and inducements deprives any married woman
- 6 of the aid, comfort and society of her husband, shall be liable
- 7 in damages to said married woman in an action on the case
- 8 brought by her within three years after the discovery of
- 9 such offence.
