STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, in favor of the Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of forty thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hun-
- 3 dred and thirteen, and the sum of forty thousand dollars,
- 4 for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, for the use of
- 5 the Maine School for Feeble-Minded;

For one dormitory brick building for school boys, and one

- 7 dormitory brick building for school girls; and that any of
- 8 the appropriation for the year nineteen hundred and thir-
- 9 teen, remaining unexpended at the end of said year, may
- 10 be available for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

Said sums to be expended under the direction of the Trus-12 tees of Maine School for Feeble-Minded.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

1913 1914

For two dormitory brick buildings of fire-proof construction for seventy school boys and seventy school girls; with dining-rooms, school-rooms, industrial rooms, and manual training rooms in the basements.

We have at the present time over sixty applications for girls, and over one hundred applications for boys. Estimating our approximate future needs from the present demand for places for children in the School, those two dormitory brick buildings would probably accommodate all the needy girls for the next four years, and all the younger or school boys, but not the older boys.
