STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, in favor of the Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and thirteen, for the use of the Maine School for
4 Feeble-Minded.

For one farm colony of wooden buildings for fifty larger
6 boys.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-
8 tees of Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This farm colony for larger boys in addition to the dormitory for school boys (referred to under another resolve), would accommodate all the boys for whom applications have been received, and probably meet the approximate future demand for the next four years.

Fifty more of the larger boys, would also enable us to carry on our farm work more economically, improve our apple orchards, build more roads and sidewalks, and make more improvements on our grounds.
