Counties of Kennebec and Somerset. (House Doc. No. 34)

Resolves. Chap. 231 of 1909 Authorized building of
bridge.

State was to pay	\$25,000

Contract for building was made with Kennebec and Som-
erset Counties. Vouchers under the resolve were seasonably
filed with State Auditor and approved by him. Demand for
payment was duly made on the state.

Both counties and the three towns paid full amount due
from them promptly and before January, 1910. The town
counties paid the amount for interest as set out in the resolve,
and as shown on copy of receipt and letter attached.
