STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Paris.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred and eighty-five
2 dollars and eighty-nine cents be and is hereby appropriated
3 to be paid the treasurer of the town of Paris for said town,
4 the same being for pauper supplies furnished Annie Mc-
5 Leod by said town of Paris, the said Annie McLeod being
6 the wife of an alien and not having any pauper residence
7 in any incorporated town in the State of Maine, but was at
8 the time of the furnishing said pauper supplies in need in
9 the town of Paris, where she never either before or after
10 marriage had any pauper residence.
