Statement of Facts accompanying Resolve in favor of Town of Island Falls. (House Doc. No. 37)

Samoille Wan came to Island Falls in July, 1906, from Boston in company with twenty-five Hungarians, to work on a tannery situated there. He remained there until December, 1906, when he became insane and was committed to the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, where he died on the twenty-fifth day of March, 1909. The town having paid the expenses of his committal and board there, and other supplies furnished him, amounting to \$578.99, respectfully asks that this amount be refunded to them by reason of the fact that the said Samoille Wan, being an alien, could not have a pauper residence in any town in the State of Maine.
