STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Jerusalem and Crocker Townships in Franklin County for the repair and permanent improvement of highways.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars, to be expended for permanent 3 improvements on highway in Jerusalem and Crocker town-4 ships, in Franklin county, between the Kingfield town line 5 and Bigelow. Said appropriation to be expended under the 6 direction of the State Highway Department.
