STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Letter E Plantation and Sandy River Plantation in Franklin County, for the repair and permanent improvement of highways.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated for the repair and permanent im- 3 provement of the highway leading from Madrid line 4 through Letter E plantation and Sandy River plantation, to 5 the old original highway from Phillips to Rangeley in 6 Franklin county. Said appropriation to be expended un- 7 der the direction of the State Highway Department.
