Statement of Facts accompanying Resolve in favor of Letter E Plantation and Sandy River Plantation in Franklin County, for the repair and permanent improvement of highways. (House Doc. No. 40)

The highway for which this appropriation is asked is the direct thoroughfare from Phillips to the Rangeley Lakes, over which there is an increasing amount of automobile travel during the summer. The road is narrow, ledgy and filled with sharp curves which make it extremely dangerous for the use of automobiles.
