STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in aid of Navigation on Sebago Lake.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred dollars is hereby
2 appropriated for the placing of buoys in Sebago lake and
3 the erection of lights in Sebago lake and the maintenance
4 of the same for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen,
5 and the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropri-
6 ated for the placing of buoys in Sebago lake and the erec-
7 tion of lights in Sebago lake and the maintenance of the
8 same for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen. Said
9 buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in Sebago
10 lake as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon.
11 All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of
12 the state steamboat inspectors; any part of the money
13 hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and main-

14 tenance of lights which shall be unexpended at the end of
15 the year nineteen hundred and fourteen shall revert back
16 to the state.
