## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT for the Improvement of Streets.

Be it cnacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Section I. Whenever a majority of the abuttors in number 2 and value upon any street or road shall in writing petition 3 the city or town officers to improve said street, highway, 4 avenue or alley, by grading, parking, curbing, gravelling, 5 macadamizing, paving or in any other way making a per-6 manent street of the same, or any part thereof, and to pro-7 vide for the making and reconstructing of such street im-8 provements, said cities and towns shall have the power to 9 assess two-thirds of the cost on the abutting property. The 10 assessment to be made in the same form as is provided for

11 sewers in chapter 21 of the Revised Statutes of Maine. In 12 determining the number and value of the abuttors on said 13 street, the last assessors' valuation of the tax assessors shall 14 be used.
