STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of Ithiel C. Blackman for maintenance of ferry across the Penobscot River between Lincoln and Chester in the county of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges which were

granted to Ithiel C. Blackman, by chapter three hundred

and forty-five of the Private and Special Laws of the year

one thousand, nine hundred and five, are hereby revived and

extended for and during the period of eight years from and

after the expiration of said charter; and all the rights, pow
res and privileges that were granted by such act may and

shall be exercised by the said Ithiel C. Blackman in the

same manner, for the same purpose and subject to the same

restrictions and obligations, as provided in said act.
