IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Albion.

Resolved: That the sum of three hundred and forty-two
2 dollars and forty-two cents be, and hereby is appropriated
3 to be paid to the Treasurer of the town of Albion for said
4 town, the same being for moneys paid by said town for the
5 expense of supporting Henrietta Lewis, Ernest Stratton and
6 Nellie Knight, insane persons unable to support themselves
7 and who had no relatives of sufficient ability legally bound
8 to support them.
