RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Solon.

Resolved: That the sum of fifty-nine dollars and thirty-
2 two cents is hereby appropriated to be paid to the town of
3 Solon, to reimburse said town for relief furnished William
4 F. Winsbury and family in the year nineteen hundred and
5 ten.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

William F. Winsbury and family are state paupers. The money asked for under the accompanying resolve was expended for relief of said family while they were quarantined by order of the local Board of Health on account of a contagious disease.
