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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and seventy-five of  
the Private and Special Laws for the year nineteen hundred  
and twelve, relative to the Wiscasset Electric Light and  
Power Company enlarging its territory.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-five and sec-  
tion one of the Private and Special Laws of Maine for the  
year nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended by  
striking out the word "town" in the eighth, thirteenth and  
sixteenth lines thereof and inserting the word 'towns' in  
said eighth, thirteenth and sixteenth lines in place thereof,  
and adding the words 'and Edgecomb' after the word  
"Wiscasset" in the said eighth and thirteenth lines, so that

9 said section as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. E. Fred Albee, H. W. Hawes, Charles I.  
11 Macurda, Enoch Leathers, C. E. Emerson, E. S. Perkins,  
12 A. W. Keirstead, W. G. Hubbard and A. H. Dodge, their  
13 associates, successors and assigns are hereby incorporated  
14 under the name of the Wiscasset Electric Light and Power  
15 Company, for the purpose of making, generating, selling  
16 and supplying electricity for lighting, heating, power, man-  
17 ufacturing or mechanical purposes, in the towns of Wiscas-  
18 set and Edgecomb, in the County of Lincoln, or for the pur-  
19 pose of buying electricity from the Portland Power and  
20 Development Company, a corporation located in the village  
21 of Damariscotta Mills in said County of Lincoln, and sell-  
22 ing such electricity for lighting, heating, power, manufac-  
23 turing and mechanical purposes, in said towns of Wiscasset  
24 and Edgecomb, or for any or either of such purposes, and  
25 for distributing, supplying and selling electricity for any or  
26 all said purposes to any corporation, firm or individual with-  
27 in said towns desiring to purchase the same, subject to the  
28 rights and liabilities incident to similar corporations as fixed  
29 by the general statutes relating thereto.’

Sect. 2. Section four of the said chapter is hereby amend-  
2 ed by striking out the word “town” in the third line and  
3 inserting the word ‘towns’ in place thereof, and adding the  
4 words ‘and Edgecomb’ after the word “Wiscasset” in  
5 said line and adding the words ‘as amended’ after the word

6 “act” in the fourth line, so that said section as amended,  
7 shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 4. Said corporation is hereby authorized to set  
9 poles and extend wires thereon in and through the streets  
10 and ways in said towns of Wiscasset and Edgecomb, as it  
11 may deem most expedient in carrying out the purposes of  
12 section one of this act as amended; also to extend its wires  
13 along and across the bridge between Wiscasset and Edge-  
14 comb subject to such reasonable restrictions as the authori-  
15 ties having the care of maintenance of such bridge may  
16 impose; and to set its poles and extend its wires thereon in  
17 and along the roads and ways in the town of Edgecomb in  
18 said county to such point as to connect with the lines of said  
19 Portland Power and Development Company, all subject to  
20 the same rights and liabilities incident to similar corpora-  
21 tions as fixed by the general statutes relating thereto.’
