STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the Home for Aged Women, located at
Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Home for Aged Women, a corporation
2 organized under the laws of this State, and located at Port-
3 land, in the County of Cumberland, which organization is
4 hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and valid,
5 is authorized and empowered for the purposes of its organ-
6 ization to receive, take and hold by deed, devise, bequest or
7 otherwise, property, personal and real, to the amount of
8 five hundred thousand dollars, including all gifts, convey-
9 ances, bequests and devises heretofore made to said cor-
10 poration.
