STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-eight of chapter fifteen of the
Revised Statutes relating to the duties of the superintendent
of schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-eight of chapter fifteen of the
2 Revised Statutes as amended by section seven of chapter
3 forty-eight of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five
4 is hereby further amended by striking out the whole of said
5 section and substituting therefor the following:

'Sect. 38. He shall, on or before the first day of August,
7 1914, and annually thereafter, make under oath a full and
8 complete return of all educational statistics for the year end-

9 ing July 1 next preceding and any town that shall fail,
10 through its school officers, to make the return required by
11 this section shall be liable to the provisions of section
12 sixteen of chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes.'
