STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, That the sums of \$150 in 1913 and \$50 in 1914 be appropriated for the placing of buoys in Lewys Long and Big Lakes in Washington County.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sums of \$150 in 1913 and \$50 in 1914 for the placing of
3 buoys in Lewys Long and Big Lakes and for the aid of nav-
4 igation on said lakes for the year 1913 \$150 and \$50 in 1914.
5 Said buoys shall be placed at such points in said lakes as will
6 best serve the needs of navigation thereon.

All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of
8 the State Steamboat inspectors.

Any part of the money hereby appropriated which shall
10 be unexpended at the end of the years 1913-1914 shall re-
11 vert to the State.
