Statement of Facts accompanying Resolve that the sums of \$150.00 in 1913 and \$50.00 in 1914, be appropriated for the placing of buoys in Lewys Long and Big Lakes in Washington County. (House Doc. No. 69)

During the summer months several steamers carrying passengers make regular trips between Princeton and Grand Lake Stream. A large number of buoys have been placed but more are necessary while those buoys placed require repainting. The ice going out carried away more or less of these buoys every year. With more than a thousand sportsmen being carried to all points on these lakes every year, it seems that safety in this respect should be guaranteed them.

About thirty-five thousand dollars was expended by visiting sportsmen at Grand Lake Stream last year.
