RESOLVE in favor of the Gardiner and Randolph Bridge.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the year 1913,  
3 only, for the purpose of repairing the bridge connecting the  
4 city of Gardiner and the town of Randolph; provided that  
5 said city of Gardiner and town of Randolph appropriate the  
6 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the same purpose:  
7 both sums to be expended under the supervision of the  
8 State Highway Department.
