STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes in relation to the fraudulent giving of checks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Whoever knowingly and wilfully, and with 2 intent to defraud, issues a check upon any bank, and uses the 3 same in payment of any debt, or demand, or in exchange 4 for money, when there are no sufficient funds in said bank 5 to redeem such check, shall be punished by imprisonment 6 for not more than two years, or by fine not exceeding one 7 thousand dollars.
