STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Roque Bluffs.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid the town of Roque
3 Bluffs in reconstructing a bridge across Marsh River, pro-
4 vided that said town of Roque Bluffs shall raise and appro-
5 priate five hundred dollars (\$500) for the same purpose:
6 both sums to be expended under the direction of the State
7 Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACT.

The town of Roque Bluffs is in poor shape financially. Their appropriations for highways and bridges for the past four years were as follows:

1907	\$300.00
1908	250.00
1909	300.00
1910	250.00

The valuation of the town for 1910 was twenty-five thousand seven hundred seventy-one dollars (\$25,771.00). The number of polls taxed was thirty-four (34). The town has twelve (12) miles of road and two (2) other bridges besides the one in question to take care of.
