STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Whiting.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to be paid to the town
3 of Whiting in Washington county, to reimburse it for cost
4 of repairs to the bridge across Holmes' Stream in said town
5 of Whiting.

STATEMENT OF FACT.

The town of Whiting is burdened with the maintenance of fifteen bridges, the lengths of which are as follows, viz: 2 between thirty-five and forty feet; 1 between thirty and thirty-five feet; 1 between twenty and twenty-five feet; 3 between fifteen and twenty feet; 4 between ten and fifteen feet; 4 between six and ten feet. It has also thirty miles of roads to maintain. Said roads are in poor condition. The tax rate is twenty-seven mills.

The town has never before been furnished or has it asked to be furnished with State aid for any purpose whatsoever.

The said bridge is on the stage road between the towns of Cutler and East Machias, and is unsafe for the traveling public. The present condition of said bridge demands immediate repairs which the town is unable to make.
