STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINF, HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to save town officers the expense of jurats upon certain returns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Town or municipal officers, who have been duly

- 2 sworn to the faithful performance of their duty shall not be
- 3 required to make oath or affirm to any report, account or
- 4 statement to be filed with any of the State departments.

Any acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith, are hereby 6 repealed.
