RESOLVE, in favor of a road in Elliottsville Plantation.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of two hundred dollars to aid in the repair of the road  
3 leading from Wilson Bridge in the plantation of Elliotts-  
4 ville, in Piscataquis county, to the Bodfish Valley Farm, so-  
5 called, near the head of Lake Onawa; the same to be ex-  
6 pended under the direction of the State Highway Depart-  
7 ment.



#### STATEMENT OF FACT.

The road named in the resolve is the chief thoroughfare to the head of Lake Onawa where is located a large summer colony that means much to the surrounding farmers. It is also a road that is used by the farmers in the winter lumbering operations. Elliottsville has a voting population of thirty-five, a valuation of \$142,425, and is heavily taxed for roads and bridge. The sum asked for is urgently needed and will greatly aid in the development of the plantation.
