STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to create the Cherryfield Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The following described territory, and the peo-

2 ple within the same, namely: So much of the town of Cher3 ryfield, in the county of Washington, beginning on the west
4 side of the Narraguagus River on the south line of the Stur-

5 gis Field, so-called, thence westerly on south line of said

6 Sturgis Field, so-called, thence westerly on south line of said

7 Sturgis Field to the highway leading to Milbridge, thence

8 across said road, or highway to the south line of the Colson

9 lot, so-called, thence following said Colson line and said Col-

10 son line extended westerly to the town line between said 11 Cherryfield and Steuben, thence northerly following said 12 town line to the line of the Washington County Railroad, 13 thence easterly following said railroad to the east line of 14 Judson M. Willey's land, thence northerly following said 15 Willey's line to the County Road leading to Franklin, thence 16 across said road and following the west line of land of the 17 heirs of Alexander and David W. Campbell to the Stillwater 18 Pond, thence easterly by said Stillwater Pond to the Dor-19 man Creek on the east side of said Stillwater Pond, thence 20 in a straight line to the southwest corner of the John Thomp-21 son pasture, so-called, thence following the south line of 22 said Thompson pasture, to the road leading from Cherry-23 field to Deblois, thence in a straight line to the southwest 24 corner of the Richard Willey Cemetery, thence southerly in 25 a straight line to the southeast corner of the A. B. Willey 26 field, so-called, on the road leading to the Willey District, 27 thence in a straight line to the northwest corner of the town 28 of Milbridge, thence following the town line of Milbridge 29 southerly to the Narraguagus River, thence by said river 30 northerly to the point of beginning, shall constitute a body 31 politic and corporate under the name of the Cherryfield 32 Water District, for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants 33 of said district and persons or parties adjacent to said dis-34 trict with pure water for domestic, sanitary, manufacturing 35 and municipal purposes.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized for the pur-

2 pose aforesaid to take water from Schoodic Pond, so-called, 3 in the towns of Cherryfield and Columbia and Township 4 number eighteen, in Washington County, State of Maine, 5 to erect and maintain reservoirs and standpipes, and lay 6 down and maintain pipes and aqueducts necessary for the 7 proper accumulating, conducting, discharging, distributing 8 and disbursing water, and forming proper reservoirs there-9 for, and said corporation may take and hold by purchase or 10 otherwise any lands or real estate necessary therefor, and 11 may excavate through any lands when necessary for the 12 purpose of this corporation.

Sect. 3. Said Water District shall be liable for all dam2 ages that shall be sustained by any person or corporation in
3 their property by the taking of any land whatsoever, or
4 water, or by flowage, or by excavating through any land for
5 the purpose of laying pipes, building dams or constructing
6 reservoirs. If any person sustaining damages as aforesaid
7 and said corporation shall not mutually agree upon the sum
8 to be paid therefor, such person may cause his damages to
9 be ascertained in the same manner and under the same con10 ditions, restrictions and limitations as are or may be pre11 scribed in the case of damages for the laying out of high12 ways.

Sect. 4. Said water district is hereby authorized to lay 2 in and through the streets and highways thereof, and of the 3 remaining portion of said town of Cherryfield, the said town 4 of Deblois adjoining said Cherryfield, said town of Colum-

5 bia, and said township number eighteen, and to take up, re6 pair and replace, all such pipes, aqueducts and fixtures as
7 may be necessary for the objects set forth as above, and
8 whenever said district shall lay any pipes or aqueducts in
9 any street or highway, it shall cause the same to be done
10 with as little obstruction as possible to the public travel, and
11 shall at its own expense without unnecessary delay, cause
12 the pavement and earth removed by it to be replaced in prop13 er condition.

Sect. 5. Said water district is hereby authorized and em2 powered to acquire by purchase or by the exercise of the
3 right of eminent domain, which right is hereby expressly
4 delegated to said water district for said purposes, any lands,
5 right of way, or any other interest in real estate which may
6 be required for the carrying out of the purposes of this cor7 poration.

Sect. 6. All the affairs of said water district shall be man2 aged by a board of trustees composed of three members to
3 be chosen by ballot by the legal voters within said water dis4 trict, the first election to be at the meeting of the legal voters
5 of said corporation, whenever said legal voters shall, at a
6 meeting called for that purpose, accept this act, one to serve
7 until the first annual meeting of said corporation, next after
8 the acceptance of this act, one to serve until the second an9 nual meeting of said corporation, next after the acceptance
10 of this act, and one to serve until the third annual meeting
11 of this corporation, next after the acceptance of this act.

Whenever the term of office of a trustee shall expire, the legal voters of said water district shall elect a successor to serve for a full term of three years, and if any other vacancy occur, it may be filled in like manner for the unexpired term. The annual meeting for the election of officers shall be in the month of April, as soon as is convenient after the board of trustees has been chosen, the said trustees shall hold a meeting and organize by the election of a chairman and clerk, adopt a corporate seal, choose a treasurer and when necessary may elect all other needful officers and agents for the proper management of the affairs of said water district.

Each member shall receive in full compensation for his ser-24 vices the sum of two dollars for each and every regular and 25 special meeting of said board at which he is in attendance.

The said water district, at any legal meeting thereof called 27 for the purpose, may adopt such by-laws and provisions, not 28 inconsistent with the constitution and laws of this state and 29 of the United States, as they may deem expedient and nec-30 essary for the good government and regulation of the mu-31 nicipal affairs of said water district, in which case, such by-32 laws and provisions so adopted shall apply to said water 33 district as fully, to all intents and purposes, as the other pro-34 visions of this act, subject to alterations and additions only 35 by a two-thirds vote of the legal voters of said water dis-36 trict present and voting at a legal meeting thereof called 37 for the purpose.

Sect. 7. For accomplishing the purposes of this act said

water district, through its trustees, is authorized to issue its 3 bonds to an amount sufficient to procure funds to pay the 4 expense incurred in the construction and installation of its 5 system of pipe lines, dams, reservoirs, pumping stations and 6 whatever equipment may be necessary or incidental to the 7 construction and installation of such system of water works, 8 and additions thereto, including the expense of taking by 9 purchase or otherwise, of lands, rights of way, or other interests in real estate which may be necessary for the car-

Said bonds shall be a legal obligation of said water district, 13 which is hereby declared to be a quasi-municipal corpora14 tion, within the meaning of section ninety-six, chapter forty15 seven of the Revised Statutes and all the provisions of said 16 section shall be applicable thereto.

- Sect. 8. The Cherryfield Water District hereby created, is 2 hereby authorized and empowered to raise annually a sum 3 of money, which in the judgment of the board of trustees, is 4 sufficient to defray the expense of furnishing water in said 5 district for the purpose of fire protection, by taxation of the 6 legally taxable property therein as rendered by the assessors 7 of said town of Cherryfield.
- Sect. 9. All individuals, firms and corporations, whether 2 public, private, national or municipal, shall pay to said water 3 district the rates established by said board of trustees for the 4 water used by them, and said rates shall be uniform within 5 the territory supplied by the water district. Said rates shall

- 6 be so established as to provide resources for the following 7 purposes:
- To pay the current running expenses for maintaining
 the water system, and to provide for such extensions and
 renewals as may become necessary.
- 2. To provide for payment of interest on the indebted-12 ness of the district.
- 3. To provide each year a sum equal to not less than one 14 nor more than five per cent of the entire indebtedness of the 15 district which sum shall be turned into a sinking fund to 16 provide for the final extinguishment of the funded debt. 17 The money set aside for the sinking fund shall be devoted 18 to the retirement of the obligations of the district or invested 19 in such securities as Savings Banks are allowed to hold.
 - Sect. 10. All the incidental powers, rights and privileges 2 necessary to the accomplishment of the main objects herein 3 set forth are granted to the corporation hereby created.
- Sect. 11. This act shall take effect when accepted by a 2 majority vote of the legal voters within said water district, 3 at any special meeting called and held for that purpose, and 4 the selectmen of the town of Cherryfield are hereby author-5 ized to call said meeting, or any subsequent meeting for that 6 purpose, and to make and provide a separate check list of 7 such voters (within said water district as are then legal 8 voters) of said town, and all warrants issued to said town 9 shall be varied accordingly to show that only such voters 10 within said district are entitled to vote thereon. Such spe-

11 cial meeting, or meetings, shall be called, advertised and 12 conducted according to the law relating to municipal election, 13 provided however, that the board of selectmen shall not be 14 required to prepare, or the town clerk to post a new list of 15 voters.

The town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this act 17 to the following question:

Shall the act to incorporate the Cherryfield Water District 19 be accepted? and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed 20 against the words, Yes, and No, their opinion of the same.

The result shall be declared by the selectmen of Cherryfield 22 and due certificate thereof filed by the town clerk with the 23 Secretary of State.
