STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

RESOLVE, in favor of repair of bridges in the town of
Dresden.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid in the repair of
3 bridges in the town of Dresden; two hundred and fifty dol-
4 lars (\$250) in the year 1913 and two hundred and fifty dol-
5 lars (\$250) in the year 1914, provided the town of Dresden
6 appropriate five hundred dollars (\$500) for the same pur-
7 pose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the
8 State Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACT.

The town of Dresden has no large villages, a population of 815, a valuation of less than one-third of a million, a high tax rate and the maintenance of its roads and bridges is a heavy burden. The town is obliged to maintain two draw-bridges at an average annual expense of about two hundred dollars in addition to the numerous smaller bridges. The sum asked for is urgently needed at this time.
