### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and seven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter two hundred fifty-six

2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and

3 ninety-seven is hereby amended by striking out the word

4 "five" in the third line of said section and inserting the word
