STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter*two hundred and fifty-six of the
Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand nine hun-
dred and seven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter two hundred fifty-six
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-seven is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 "five" in the third line of said section and inserting the word
5 'ten' in place thereof, so that said section as amended shall
6 read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall not be
8 less than two hundred and fifty thousand dollars nor more

9 than ten million dollars, as the stockholders shall from time
10 to time determine, and shall be divided into shares of one
11 hundred dollars each.'
