STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter two of the Public Laws of 1911.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That said act be and hereby is amended by adding thereto a section reading as follows:

The provisions of this act shall not apply to that part of
4 Penobscot Bay west and north of the following described
5 lines: A line drawn from Cape Rosier to the north point of
6 North Haven and following the northwest shore of said
7 North Haven to its southwest point commonly called Crab-
8 tree's Point and thence to the west point of Matinicus;
9 thence from said west point of Matinicus to White Head
10 Light.'
