STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

---

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred sixty-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five as amended by Chapter twenty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, relating to taxing soldiers and sailors.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of Chapter one hundred sixty-  
2 three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, as  
3 amended by Section one of Chapter twenty of the Public  
4 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, is hereby amended  
5 by striking out, in lines two and three, the words "in the war  
6 of eighteen hundred and sixty-one and five" and inserting

7 in place thereof the words 'in any war', so that said section  
8 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Every soldier or sailor who served in the army  
10 or navy of the United States in any war, and who has an  
11 honorable discharge from such service, resident within the  
12 State of Maine, is hereby forever exempt from the assess-  
13 ment of and payment of a poll tax within any city, town or  
14 plantation in this state, provided, however, that any such  
15 sailor or soldier who desires to pay said tax may, on or be-  
16 fore the first day of April, in each year, notify in writing  
17 the assessors of the city, town or plantation in which he  
18 resides of his desire to pay said tax, whereupon said assess-  
19 ors shall assess said tax against said soldier or sailor, and  
20 said soldier or sailor shall be legally holden to pay said tax.'
