STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 106 of the Laws of 1911, entitled An Act relative to Condemnation Proceedings of Land for Public Purposes, so that said act as added and amended shall read:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Following Section 8 in said act there shall be 2 added the following section:

'Sect. 9. All condemnation proceedings for land other-4 wise subject to the provisions of this act begun after March 5 28, 1911, wherein proceedings for the assessment of dam-6 ages have not been begun before January 1, 1913, are here-7 by made subject to the revisions of this act. Provided pro-8 ceedings are instituted in accordance with the provisions

9 of this act for a hearing upon the necessity of the taking 10 within thirty (30) days after this section takes effect.' So 11 that said section as amended and added shall read:

'Sect. 9. All condemnation proceedings for land otherwise 13 subject to the provisions of this act begun after March 28, 14 1911, wherein proceedings for the assessment of damages 15 have not been begun before January 1, 1913, are hereby 16 made subject to the provisions of this act. Provided pro17 ceedings are instituted in accordance with the provisions 18 of this act for a hearing upon the necessity of the taking 19 within thirty (30) days after this section takes effect.'
