STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and sixty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to grant certain powers to Hancock County Trustees of public reservations."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two and three of chapter three hundred and sixty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, are hereby amended, so that said sections as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have power to acquire, by devise, gift or purchase, and to own, arrange, hold, maintain and improve, for free public use, lands in Hancock county, Maine, which by reason of scenic beauty, historical

9 interest or sanitary advantages may be available for that
10 purpose.

Sect. 3. Lands and improvements thereon, held by said
12 corporation, for free public use, shall be exempt from state,
13 county or town taxation except in the town of Eden.'
