STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the Assistant Assessors of the City of
Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The assessors of the City of Portland shall ap-
2 point annually an assistant assessor in each ward, whose
3 duty it shall be to furnish them with all the necessary in-
4 formation relative to persons and property taxable in his
5 ward; he shall be sworn or affirmed to the faithful perform-
6 ance of his duty. Assistant assessors so appointed shall
7 act under the direction of the assessors and according to
8 the rules prescribed by them, and the said assessors shall
9 have full control in appointing and removing such assist-
10 ants and filling all vacancies.

Sect. 2. The compensation for the assistant assessors
2 named according to the provisions of the foregoing section
3 shall be \$3 per diem of eight hours, with allowance at the
4 same rate for such overtime as may be required by the as-
5 sessors of the City of Portland, and under their direction.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are
2 hereby repealed.
