STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Sanford to Own, Maintain and Operate a Gas Plant.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The town of Sanford is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to acquire, own, maintain and operate a gas
3 plant, and for such purpose said town is vested with the
4 power to raise money, as hereinafter provided, for the pur5 chase or lease of lands, buildings, machinery and personal
6 property necessary for properly equipping, operating and
7 maintaining said gas plant.

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Sect. 2. Said town of Sanford is also hereby authorized 2 and empowered to use the gas by it manufactured and gen-3 erated to light its streets, roads, and public squares, and all 4 buildings or parts of buildings owned, used or occupied by 5 it; and said town is further authorized to sell, distribute 6 and furnish gas for lighting, heating, manufacturing, and 7 mechanical purposes to individuals and corporations within 8 the limits of said town of Sanford.

Sect. 3. For the purposes of establishing, operating, and 2 maintaining said gas plant the said town of Sanford is here-3 by authorized and empowered to take, lease, purchase, and 4 hold all real estate and personal property necessary or con-5 venient, and may construct, lay, maintain, and operate lines 6 of pipe for the transmission of gas underground, over, under 7 and along any and all streets, roads, or ways within the lim-8 its of said town of Sanford and for the purposes of laying 9 its pipes and distributing gas said town shall have authority 10 to take such rights in real estate across private land as may 11 be necessary.

Sect. 4. The board of selectmen of said Sanford are here-2 by authorized and empowered, on behalf of said town, to 3 purchase any land together with all rights, privileges, and 4 easements appurtenant thereto, or to lay pipes across the 5 land of any person or corporation, necessary in carrying out 6 the purposes of this act; and if the said board of select-7 men are unable to purchase from the owners therof any 8 such land or easement in such land as they deem necessary

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9 to have in carrying out the purposes of this act or cannot 10 agree with the said owners upon the price to be paid for 11 such land or the easement therein; then the said town of 12 Sanford, by its board of selectmen, are hereby authorized 13 and empowered to enter upon, take and hold said land or 14 easement therein; and within thirty days after entering 15 upon and determining the quantity of land to be taken and 16 held and the boundaries thereof, said selectmen shall file in 17 the registry of deeds for the County of York, notice of said 18 taking, together with plans and descriptions of said land, 19 with the purposes for which it is taken, signed by the afore-20 said selectmen, and after filing said plan, description and 21 purposes, may enter upon, take and hold the land or ease-22 ments in said land included in said description for the pur-23 poses herein designated, and may use any portion of the 24 land so taken and held for the purposes mentioned and con-25 templated in this act, the damages therefor to be assessed 26 by the County Commissioners of York County upon appli-27 cation therefor, by either the owners of said property so · 28 taken or by the selectmen of said Sanford, said application 29 to be made within six months after the filing of said notice, 30 plan and description before mentioned. Such damages are 31 to be assessed in the same manner and under the same re-32 strictions, conditions, limitations and rights of appeal, as 33 are by law prescribed in the case of damages for the laving 34 out of highways, so far as such law is consistent with the 35 provisions of this act.

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Sect. 5. Said town of Sanford for the purpose of carry-2 ing into full effect the provsions of this act in the establish-3 ing, constructing, furnishing, equipping and fully maintain-4 ing said gas plant, may at its annual town meeting or at 5 any legal meeting called for that purpose, raise money, and 6 issue bonds, in such denominations, and on such time and 7 rate of interest as may be determined at such meeting to an 8 amount necessary for said purpose, which taken in connec-9 tion with any other indebtedness of said town will not ex-10 ceed five per centum of the last regular valuation thereof. 11 Said bonds shall be signed by the selectmen and treasurer 12 of said town of Sanford.

Sect. 6. The building, equipping, care and management 2 of said gas plant shall be under the control of the select-3 men; or if the legal voters of said town of Sanford at its 4 annual town meeting or at any meeting legally called for 5 that purpose, so vote, said duties shall be placed in the hands 6 of a commission, the members of which shall be chosen in 7 town meeting as other municipal officers are chosen, and 8 shall be known as "Commissioners of Public Service." If 9 such commission is chosen it shall then exercise the powers 10 and duties hereinbefore given to the board of selectmen for 11 equipping, maintaining, and operating said gas plant. Said 12 commission shall consist of three members who shall be le-13 gal voters of said town of Sanford, one chosen for one year, 14 one chosen for two years, and one chosen for three years 15 and after the first year one shall be chosen each year for16 the term of three years, and in case a vacancy occurs in such17 commission the selectmen may appoint a member to act un-18 til the next annual town meeting.
