STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and seventy-seven of
the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating
to Common School Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter seventy-seven of the Public Laws
2 of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "one third of," in the first line in said section,
4 also all of said section three after the word "year" in the
5 ninth line of said section. Said section three when amend-
6 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. This fund shall be distributed by the treasurer
8 of state on the first day of January annually to the several
9 cities, towns and plantations according to the number of
10 scholars therein as the same shall appear from the official
11 returns made to the state superintendent of schools for the
12 preceding year.'
